 - We spent \$21,354.022025- \$34,246.22- down from previous year due to B park concessions not being fully available.

 - c. Weed eaters and edges, gas powered (2 each) We currently only have 1 blower at B park, we could use 1 more
 - d. Portable mound, which has already been approved for C park.
 - e. Green paint 5 gallons (2)
- Push mowers at A and B park might need to be professionally serviced. I can definitely do what I can but I will be honest I'm not a mechanic. I know the basics but I don't know everything about them. We can have the Rental Place in RP do the service.
- Each field has the proper maintenance tools in order to be maintained. (Shovels, rakes, brooms)
- Bases will be determined as needed. I will inspect all field bases to make sure they are intact as well as the installation pegs.
- The clinic this week will be on watch pending weather.
- Budget was not assigned- no buying anything at this time until we start bringing in some \$. Okay to get C park
